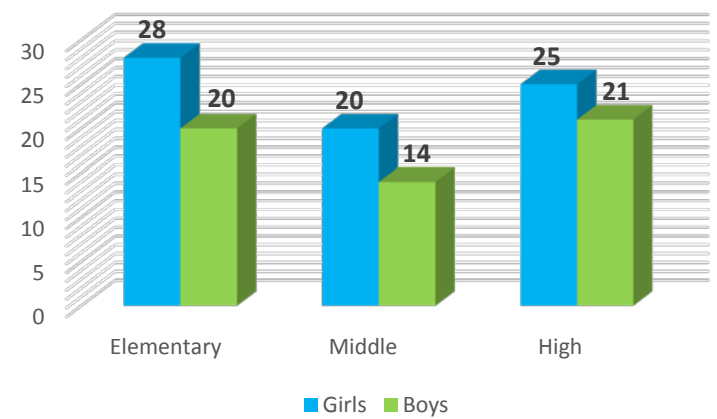


Analysis of New Students Admitted to Odyssey in 2016

What is the composition of our new student group?

Ratio of Girls to Boys by School Level



We are serving more girls than boys. **Girls make up 57%** of our total new student group.

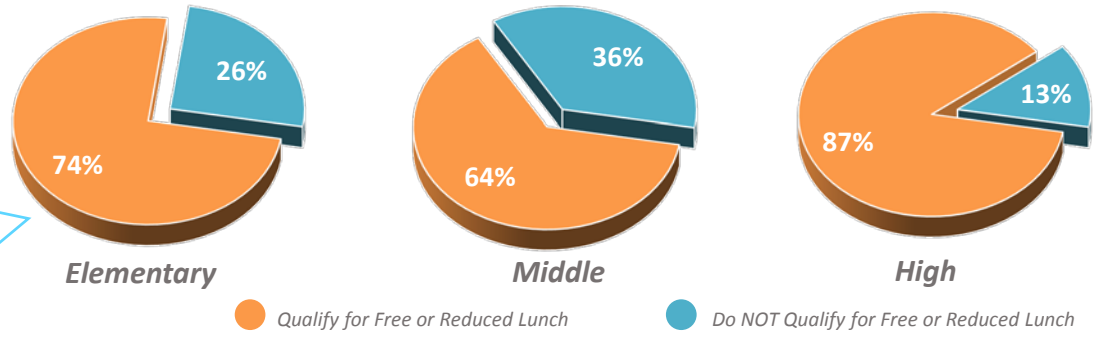
On average across all three levels, **76%** of our new students qualify for **free or reduced lunch**.

72.6% of our students come from **households that make \$55,000 per year or less**.

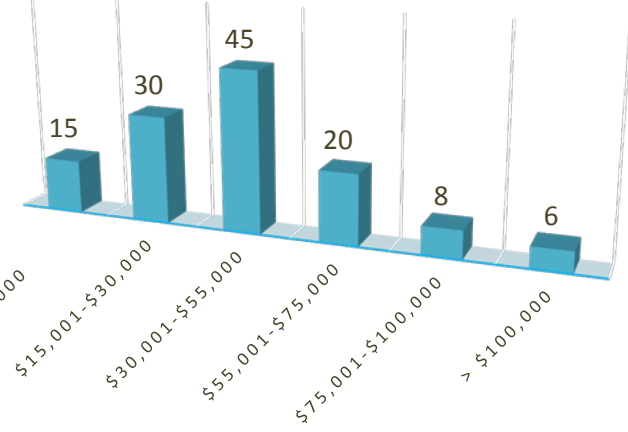
Our students come from **37 different zip codes** across the Metro Atlanta area.

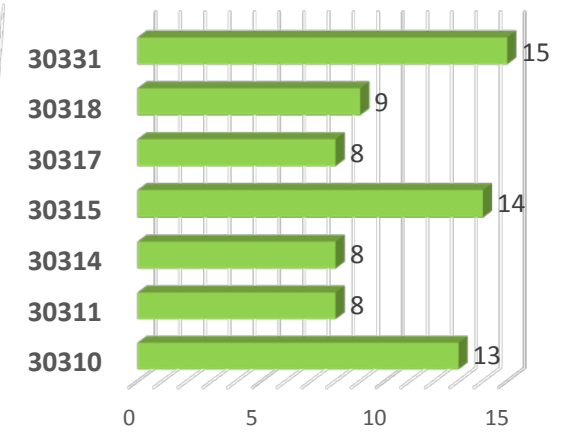
% of New Students who Qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch by School Level



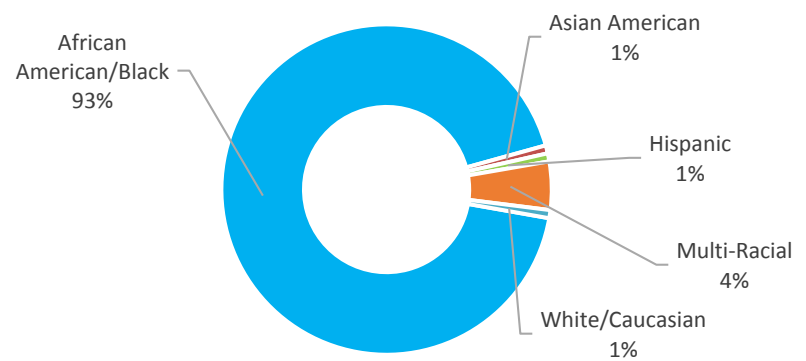
Distribution of New Students by Self-Identified Household Income Range

Distribution of New Students by Preferred Racial Identity

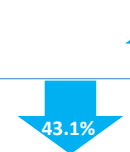

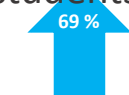
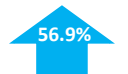

New Odyssey Students attend a Charter School

43.1% of our APS students come from schools with CCRPI below state average



56.9% of our APS students come from schools with CCRPI above state average



Of our APS students who come from schools with CCRPI above state average, **69%** of those schools are 10 or more points above state average

State Average CCRPI = 72.3

Of our **48** students that attend charter schools, **18** of those attend Drew Charter, **13** attend a KIPP school, **6** attend Kindezi, **4** attend Wesley International Academy
